This job will involve all aspects of Yacht engineering including, but not limited to : Diesel and Outboard Engine maintenance, 12v and 220v electrics, electronics, fibreglass repair, gel coat repair, rigging, underwater work.

The ideal candidate needs to have a good knowledge of at least 3 of the above topics, possibly not in the marine world. You need to be willing to put in the extra hours to learn new skills. Due to the nature of our work sometimes work hours will extend past the normal working day or start before the normal working hours due to operational needs – we work the hours that are necessary to make sure the boats go on charter without any problems. If a problem occurs at any time when a boat is on charter, we fix it.
